■There are many types of harmony, for example there is musical harmony. Musical harmony the combination of simultaneous notes producing chords and chord progressions having a pleasing effect.

■There is the harmony of the gospel; the arrangement of the four gospels are written by four different individuals but they are in harmony of purpose. They all explains the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus.

■A chord in music is any harmonic set of pitches consisting of multiple notes(also called pitches) that are heard as if sounding simultaneously.

■Chord progression or harmonic progression is a succession of chords. The harmony of chords releases a melody and rhythm.

■A chord can have different notes in it but when played in sequence are heard simultaneously.

■The gospel message like a chord in music when preached under the anointing creates a sound. The pitch within the chord of the Gospel causes simultaneous response and have a pleasing effect. The pleasing effect causes us to hear the melody and get into rhythm.

■The sound can be heard as being simultaneous.

■Each Gospel is like a musical chord that gives simultaneous and progressive melody and

rhythm.

■ Rhythm helps us to get into sequence.

Acts 2:1 "And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. "

Acts 2:2 "And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting."

The group of 120 were all in one place with one accord. If we take the word "accord" and view as a "chord" in music. A chord in music is a group of notes heard in sequence and a progression of chords gives a pleasing affect.

■ The sound is from Heaven, therefore the sound brings the listeners into sequence with heaven's purpose.

■ The sequence of the chords(sound) caused everyone to hear the same thing at the same time. The Holy Spirit places the chords and the sequence brings all 120 into rhythm.
